California Transition Rules for Lifetime Builder and Lifetime Builder Elite

On May 7, Lifetime Builder Elite will replace Lifetime Builder in California. **The earliest application signed date that will be accepted for Lifetime Builder Elite is May 7, 2018.**

Important Dates for final applications for Lifetime Builder in California

These deadlines apply to applications for Lifetime Builder and related versions of riders, including the Early Cash Value (ECV) rider.

- **May 25:** Last day Lifetime Builder applications can be **signed**
- **June 1:** Last day Lifetime Builder applications can be **received** in the Home Office
- **July 31:** Last day for Lifetime Builder policies to be **issued**

Please Note: If you currently have a Lifetime Builder application in the underwriting process and would like to change that application to Lifetime Builder Elite, please submit a cover letter and Lifetime Builder Elite illustration to our New Business team. If the policy has already been underwriter approved, Issue Instructions will be sufficient.
